How To Remove Deep Stains

Forgot to seal and now you have a deep, stubborn oil-based stain on your stone? A natural stone poultice will wick up the stain and restore your stone back to its original condition.

Items needed

- · StoneTech 3 Oz. Oil Stain Remover
- Tool to mix & apply poultice (plastic or wood spatula)
- Tool to remove poultice (brush)
- · Mineral spirits

Instructions

- 1) Always test in a small inconspicuous area to determine that the desired results will be achieved.
- 2) Make sure surface is clean, dry and free of waxes and coatings.
- Using a plastic or wood spatula, stir poultice thoroughly to mix. 3)
- 4) Apply a 1/4" thick layer of paste to the stain. Insure that the paste extends at least 1"-2" beyond the edge of the stain.
- 5) Do not cover.
- 6) Allow 48-72 hours for paste to completely dry to a powder.
- 7) Sweep up powder with a dry brush and discard powder.
- 8) Allow poultice to completely dry from the stone.
- 9) If stain is not completely gone after drying, repeat process.
- 10) Clean up residue and tools with mineral spirits.
- 11) To prevent future staining, reseal the area with a sealer designed for stone. We recommend using StoneTech 24Oz. Natural Stone sealer.
- 12) Regularly clean surface with a neutral, maintenance cleaner formulated for stone. We recommend using StoneTech Revitalizer.
